Hi Folks,

I have just picked up two 16/80 radiator shells from the polisher. Both have been beautifully restored and re-plated. They cost several hundred pounds each to bring them to this condition. Also bear in mind that an M45 radiator has 18 slats and at about £25.00 each that's another £450!

Tim restored and polished the shells and then sent them to an independent plater for the copper and chrome plating.

Tim also does lost-wax castings.
