Dear David,

finally I removed the rear seat backrest and underside. I assume mine is not original either. The underside of the rear seat is covered with black cloth, so you can't see in but at one corner it was a bit loose and I could find foam rubber cushions inside. The rear seat backrest is shown in the other photo, it has rubber foam inside too (no springs in both).

When I had the seat away I checked the filling of the shock absorbers, one was quite low, so it was worth taking the photos
