I think that the knob is possibly a speaker balance for the radio, if it's had a second speaker fitted. Switch could be for anything, and the button... maybe it's a starter button?

Another very helpful owner has directed me as follows :

1. Knurled knob to the left is speaker balance, front to back.
2. Middle non-standard switch - unknown
3. Far right push button is for the petrol filler cap release.

The Rapide does not have a starter button, it has an ignition key and choke which is needed when starting from cold.
