The ad for this car is on the Classic Cars For Sale website complete with pictures and the Jersey vendors claim that the car has only been confirmed for sale "since yesterday" - which is a lie, the car has been advertised for many months. You can see the ad at:

However, the same car is actually in Hampshire and really for sale at Beaulieu Garages; they ask 65.000 pounds. They too have an ad on internet (on their own website). See:

I was interested in the car and when I tried to find out what was going on I send a very polite email to Le Riche but their answer was so weird ("best come to germany and buy it at techno classica") that I am inclined to think that this is an attempt at a scam of some sort.
