I wasn't planning to put a pad under the bonnet as I don't think there was one originally, but if drumming is a problem I might reconsider! I'm quite proud of the original brake fluid caps...and they work! For those who don't know, the red ignition light also tells you when your handbrake is on and if the brake fluid is low...
